How can the Cyber Insurance and Incident Response industries work more collaboratively?

CREST is running a workshop that will look at how the cyber insurance and incident response industries can work more closely together.

The technical security industry has a general lack of confidence in the value of cyber insurance. A major reason for this is a lack of understanding of what the policies are designed to cover and how they fit into the wider cyber assurance and recovery processes. There is also concern that cyber insurance is too broad and has far reaching exclusions.

There is also a lack of understanding in the cyber insurance industry about the benefits it can derive from working with cyber security incident response services providers, both to reduce the

likelihood of an incident and the claim value resulting from its impact. This needs greater insight into the cyber security market and the schemes and qualifications that are used to support the industry.

It is also important to understand how incident information gathered through insurance and recovery activities could be shared to allow organisations to be better prepared for cyber attacks.

The workshop aims to explore these issues and provide a platform for a collaborative view on existing and future activity. The output of the day will include an agreed set of actions that the industry can take to make a positive impact and a plan for how to move this forward.
