We are delighted that so many people have registered for CRESTCon, and the CREST team looks forward to speaking to you in person, after so many months of virtual events, and virtual meetings. We thank all of our sponsors for helping to support CRESTCon, and we look forward to hearing many great talks and presentations that are scheduled to be delivered across the event.

Make sure you continue to follow us on Linkedin, and keep an eye out for some email based member comms. We expect to announce a major new initiative in July, that is designed to improve security testing standards across the globe. Nick Benson, CREST CEO: Listening, learning, reflecting and planning



My first two months in role have been a great opportunity for me to listen to our members, get to know the cyber sector and start to plot out the future in more detail.

It was a particular pleasure to launch our new strategy, vision and mission to our membership over webinar in June. Feedback from the event has been very positive, with appreciation of the renewed vigour, ambition and focus that we presented. If you didn't attend, members can contact **marketing@crest-approved.org** for a recording of the presentation to hear about how CREST 3.0 will offer a significantly broadened and strengthened value proposition to members in the years to come.

Another highlight so far has been meeting so many of our dedicated council members who steer both the direction of CREST regionally and contribute to the overall direction of CREST internationally. The passion and enthusiasm are palpable. The central team and I will be spending much time over the coming months working out how we can do more to harness this and give the regions the tools, autonomy and support to make CREST even better in their local regions.

A useful reference point has also been the two overseas trips I have done so far with Rowland and Andy. We spent four days visiting three countries in the Middle East, including the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with the Qatari National Cyber Security Agency (NCSA) (more information **here**). The visit highlighted the valuable role that both CREST and its members can play in accelerating the advancement of cyber capability in a country.

In contrast, we attended the RSA Conference in San Francisco, the largest cyber security conference in the world I am told. The scale was remarkable, as was the cutting-edge nature of the presentations and exhibitors. The US market provides huge opportunity for CREST member firms, and we are increasingly positive about the progress we can make there over the next 6-12 months, with the fantastic support of the Americas council.

In summary, I am left enthused and optimistic following my initial period of listening, learning and reflecting. The next stage is to convert that into an executable plan, which I look forward to sharing more about in my subsequent updates.

Exams

Andy Woolhead CREST Global Head of Product: Exam preparation and focused training

In line with CREST's new vision and mission to raise professional standards and provide capability, capacity and consistency across the global community, we are well underway with our partnerships with both Hack the Box and Immersive Labs to offer back some focused training aligned to the CREST certifications.

Mapping of content is well underway and we have now got a blueprint of what the offer might look like for our members. To manage expectations, we do not have a bottomless pit of funding to generate a solution which will provide 100% free training across all of the CREST certifications and in reality, not everyone learns in this way. What we will be able to provide is some focused training using practical labs across the two partners' platforms which will take individuals on the learning journey to better prepare for CREST certifications.

As we engage with candidates and members, one of the themes is exam preparation and it is something we have listened to and are focused on improving. We are in the process of reviewing are exam content and to better align it to current practices and of course to better signpost candidates' preparation.

With Hack The Box, there is likely to be a pathway for each of the Penetration Testing Exams which will take an individual so far down the curriculum (distance tbc) to allow individuals the opportunity to touch and feel the labs and experientially develop and hone their skills in a particular area. Exclusive vouchers that will give periodic unrestricted access to all HTB content, including CREST Mapped content, will be allocated to Member organisations (numbers tbc) and once the free journey has been completed there will be an opportunity to purchase the full curriculum. CREST has secured and will also look to fund access to a limited number of exclusively created Dedicated Labs (numbers and distribution model tbc) with CREST-mapped content, with the ability to upgrade at a preferential discounted rate (more info will follow). Whilst we would love to fund the entire journey, we simply don't have the resource to fund it and hope that it complements an individuals' additional preparation.

For Immersive Labs there will be a similar but subtly different approach. Free access will be granted to CREST members aligned to a specific CREST pathway for the CTI and IR curriculum which will also include a number of

other labs outside the curriculum. The second offering, again funded by CREST will be a focused lab-based training programme for the more advanced courses and we still need to determine how much of the learning pathway we can fund but there is likely again to be an option to purchase the full suite.

I am certain there will be plenty of questions around how this the programme will ultimately look but I wanted to provide an update which colours in some of the detail we are discussing with both HTB and IL. We are aiming for an Autumn launch and whilst we will be making every effort to accelerate this, the devil is in the detail, and I hope to be able to provide some further updates as the process matures. Both HTB and IL have been incredibly forward leaning into the project and we remain as excited as we were at the start of the journey – More to follow!

The skilled person registration process has been live for just over two months now and thank you to the members who have already provided us with the names of the individuals they would like to register with CREST. Many of these individuals have already fully completed the process and have received their Unique CREST ID.

The additional information around the skills and competencies held within the teams responsible for delivering CREST Accredited services on behalf of members will be hugely beneficial in allowing members to display themselves in the best possible way to potential clients.

We plan to start implementing some of the additional information captured by the skilled person register into the buyer's journey on the website later this year.

We would encourage any member that has not already done so to start the process as soon as possible so that they can be included in this initial wave of implementation.

We have designed the registration to be as quick and simple as possible.


There is still time to stand a chance of winning some discounts and goodies by updating your profile on the CREST website.

This legislation enhances the partnership between industry and government to ensure Australia's social and economic stability.
